

## Transmission: Cinema/Psychoanalysis

### Information for Participants

#### Travel to Cambridge

##### **By National Express coach** (<http://www.nationalexpress.com/>)

There are **direct** National Express coach services to Cambridge which leave Heathrow approximately every 30 minutes. The journey takes about 2hrs 50min. From Stansted - the nearest airport to Cambridge - the journey takes about 50min. The bus station is situated under the airport.

##### **By Train** (<http://www.nationalrail.com>)

There is a direct Underground/Tube train connection between Heathrow and central London via the Piccadilly Line (marked navy blue on the Tube map). The Piccadilly Line goes straight to King's Cross from where you can then catch the train to Cambridge. The journey time on the Piccadilly Line is about 1h 15min into King's Cross. A faster line is the Heathrow Express which takes you into Paddington Station from where you can connect with the Tube. It is a 15 minute non-stop ride. You may take the Underground from Paddington Station to King's Cross, but bear in mind that if you are going directly to Cambridge from Heathrow, your total travel time on either route will be the same. Moreover the Underground connection at Paddington involves many stairs (no elevator) – not fun with heavy luggage!

There is also a direct train from Stansted. Train departure times are on visual display in the arrival hall.

## **Conference Venues (see maps below)**

Evening of the 16<sup>th</sup> September: CRASSH, 17 Mill Lane

All day 17-18<sup>th</sup> September: Emmanuel College (Queen's Building), St. Andrew's Street and Arts Picturehouse Cinema, 38-39 St. Andrew's St.

Walking from the station to CRASSH will take about 30 minutes whilst a taxi journey will not take more than 10 minutes (a taxi costs £5-7). The walk from the station to Emmanuel takes about 20 minutes.

There is a direct shuttle bus from the railway station into town, which leaves every 10 minutes. Alight at Emmanuel on St. Andrew's St. The Arts Picturehouse is across the road from the College. To find CRASSH walk down Downing St, continue along Pembroke St, cross Trumpington St and turn right into the alleyway behind the Cambridge University Press building. Look for signs for the Cambridge Graduate Union and Blue Cafe. The entrance to CRASSH looks down on the Courtyard/parking lot.

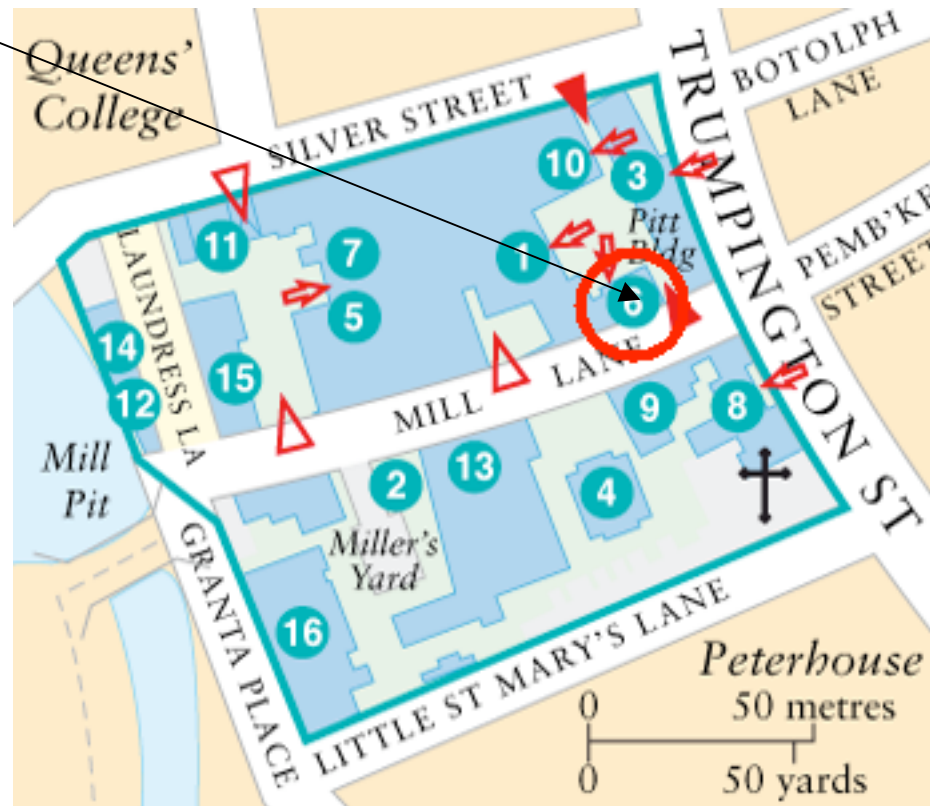


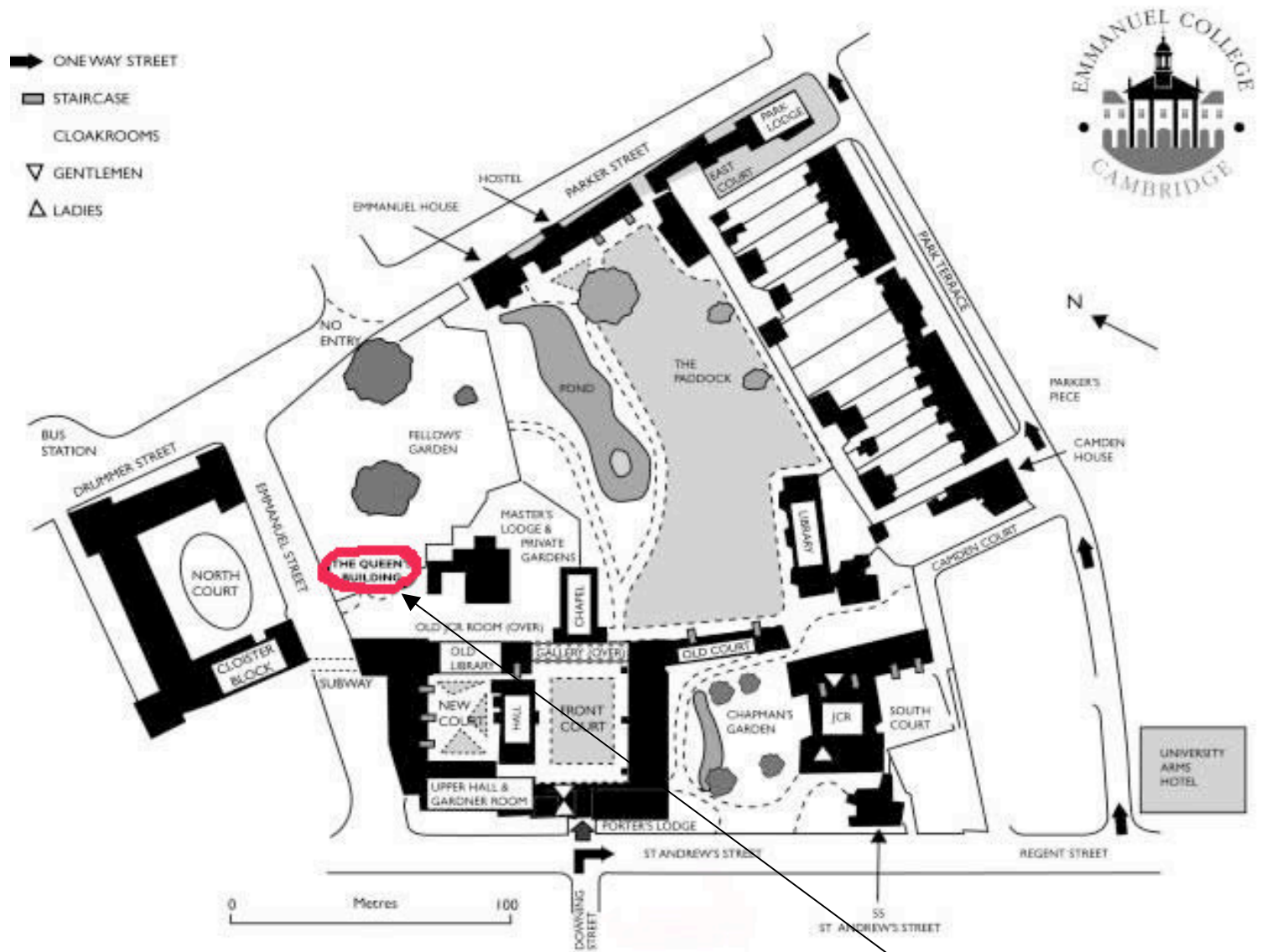
